

Maths

In maths we are looking at multiplication, money and statistics. We are following the White Rose scheme of work in maths

Music

Listen to rain sounds and develop a tune using body percussion involving different body parts, and different people in orchestra.

Art

Create a work of art based on the painting of the tiger by Henri Rousseau.

Science

We will learn the functions of different parts of a flowering plant: root, stem/trunk, leaves and flowers. Understand the requirement of plants for life and growth (air, light, water, nutrients from the soil and room to grow) and how they vary from plant to plant.
