

The Gillford Centre
 Primary PE & School Sports Premium
 2019/20



The government is providing additional funding of £150 million per annum to improve provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools. This funding - provided jointly by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport - will be allocated to primary school head teachers. This funding is ring-fenced and therefore can only be spent on provision of PE and sport in schools. In the academic year 2019/20, The Gillford Centre was granted £3396.

Goalposts	£568	New goalposts have been purchased to be used for both curriculum PE lessons as well as breaktimes. These are static and portable goalposts to improve the quality of delivery of PE and increase participation in sport at social times	It is hoped that the static goalposts will last for a minimum of ten years and that the portable goalposts will last for a minimum of five years
New Playground	£2828 – Part funding towards	In order to try and increase sport participation we have invested in a new playground. This will be used at all social times	There is a 25 year warranty with the new playground equipment
